DON STEVENS.

Don Stevens is arriving in Australia and will share the Anniversary of Beloved Baba's visit to Avatar's Abode with us on Sunday, June 10th, leaving on Monday, June 11th, to fly to Sydney.

Don Stevens is not well known to Australians, so we asked Craig San Roque to write an introduction for Don and to give us some background. Don Stevens has spent most of his life in Europe, Britain and the U.S.A.

"Don is a graduate in Chemistry of the John Hopkins University, U.S.A. He became a research chemist and at his retirement was a distinguished member of the International oil/energy community having been, among other things, Vice President of Standard Oil, and Energy Consultant to the Spanish Government.

He was co-editor with Ivy Duce on 'God Speaks' and 'The Discourses of Meher Baba'. Don's own publications include 'Listen Humanity', 'Man's Search for Certainty', 'Listen the New Humanity' and most recently 'The Inner Path and The New Life'. He has been active in facilitating the translation of Meher Baba's Discourses into Spanish, French, German.

As I look back over Don's life with Meher Baba since the early 1950's and at my own experience with him over 20 years of friendship, I can see certain patterns and preoccupations which Don has consistently and creatively pursued. I'll mention a few of them here.

I am struck by his commitment to Baba's teachings, to his words believing as I do, that Baba didn't waste a word or a moment and that Baba's actual words are a condensed powerhouse of the Avatatic wisdom. I am struck by Don's advocacy of our right to experiment with our inner life and with our relationship with Meher Baba and upon Don's reliance upon the example of the Avatar's life as a guideline for our own. The New Life in particular. Don has consistently pressed the value of committed group life as a forum for discovering one's own unique companionship with the Avatar.

Don is a man of intellect and sophistication, he is a man of remarkable flexibility, warmth and perception. He has a fascination with detail, above all with the detailed care which Baba takes with the lives of his lovers. Don is convinced (as I am) that Baba (in His universal work) has made detailed arrangements for and with the lives and relationships of his lovers. That the spiritual task confronting all of us to make the Avatar our constant companion and by so doing let the detailed arrangements made by Baba have their say and their effect in our daily lives, internally and in relationships.

Don is a loyal friend, and it is great that he will be here on June 10th, and I hope you get to enjoy his company. He will be in Sydney June 11th - 14th, and then leaves for Los Angeles. Opportunities will be made for Sydney People to meet him.

A FAREWELL TO MARGARET CRASKE.

Margaret Craske, dancer and teacher, and lover of Meher Baba, born 26th November 1992, died at Myrtle Beach, Sth. Carolina 18th February, 1990.

"When a great teacher dies, a light goes out. So it seems with Margaret Craske, one of the greatest teachers of classical ballet this century." (Quote from The Independent Gazette, U.K.22.2.90)

Margaret danced briefly with the Diaghilev Ballet just after the First World War, her long life carried forward the Diaghilev legacy not as a dancer, but as a teacher, teaching the method of Enrico Cecchetti. She was ballet mistress to the American Ballet Theatre in the late 40's, taught at the Metropolitan Opera School & the Juilliard School, and then held her own studio at East 31st St, New York until a few years before her death. She co-authored *The Theory & Practice of Allegro in Classical Ballet* - a bible to all teachers of the Cecchetti method. Other books co-authored by her are *The Practice of Allegro*, & *The Practice of Advanced Allegro*. These books and the quality of her teaching established her unique authority in the ballet world.

However, Margaret Craske also had another love, one which all Baba-lovers all over the world share - Meher Baba. She met Baba on His first visit to London in 1931, and became one of His earliest western disciples. She spent time with Him in India and on His instructions moved to the U.S. in 1946. Margaret's first impression of Baba when she first saw Him was "A vision of gentleness, grace and love that touched the heart immeasurably". Before that first day was over, she said, "I only knew from that moment, whatever rough treatment He may have afterwards handed out, there has never been a moment's doubt as to His being the embodiment of Love and Life."

Margaret Craske has written a book of short stories of her fifty years of life with Baba - *'The Dance of Love'*. It is a treasure telling with simplicity and directness of His relationship with some of His closest disciples.

Margaret Craske said of Baba - "Baba did not just love - He was love".

Our Guest Speaker for the 1990 Anniversary at Avatar's Abode is

CHARLES HAYNES

Charles was a child of eight when he first met Avatar Meher Baba at Meher Spiritual Centre in the United States during Baba's last visit to the west in 1958. He was introduced to Meher Baba by Elizabeth Patterson, one of Baba's early western disciples. In 1962, Charles and his family responded to Baba's invitation and attended the East-West Gathering in Poona, India.

Charles now serves as Vice President and member of the Board for Meher Spiritual Centre. He is the author of "Meher Baba, the Awakener", a recently published book about the life and work of the Avatar.

In his professional life, Charles is the executive Director of The First Liberty Institute, a non-profit educational institute established to foster a constructive understanding of religious liberty in American education. He also serves as President of the National Council on Religion and Public Education. He is the author of "Religion in American History: What to teach and How", "Religious Freedom in America", and co-author of "Living With Our Deepest Differences: Religious Liberty in a Pluralistic Society".

Charles Haynes is a graduate of Emory University (B.A., Religion), Harvard Divinity School (M.T.S., Religion and Education) and Emory University (Ph.D., Theological Studies).

Charles will be talking at the Anniversary about his experiences as a child with Meher Baba.

Jai Baba dear David, Sheila & boys,

I feel we must share a recent lovely experience in Beloved Baba's love.

On Monday this week we had a rare chance to hear, meet and share HIS LOVE with your old schoolmate Tuck Andress and Patti. Truly a memorable and very wonderful occasion for those present.

Tuck and Patti were in N.Z. for the first time, specifically for the Wellington Festival of the Arts where they were performing.

We knew of their coming and had been sorry that it was to be Wellington only - however, this was to change as here it was arranged that they come to Christchurch also.

We knew this only a few weeks ago and I took the opportunity to write a 'Welcome to N.Z.' letter to them c/o The Wellington Festival Director, who I know.

New Zealand is basically a land of two islands, Wellington, our capital city is in the north island as is Auckland, by far the largest city, (on our scale) - Christchurch is in the south island and has an active Baba group. Pop 300,000.

Chris Doig, the Wellington Festival Director had been until fairly recently, the Director of our Christchurch Arts Centre, a central block of old stone original university buildings, which were converted into a centre for Art when the university was relocated on a large suburban site 25 years ago about.

This director friend had been influential in making it possible for Tuck & Patti to extend their N.Z. visit to the Arts Centre, Christchurch - for one concert only!

They had come here direct from a tour of Japan and after their few days were headed for Sydney & 3 weeks in Australia, where they had performed before.

Some days before their coming to Christchurch I had made contact with the person who was looking after their short stay here and who would be meeting them at the airport. I went to see her and handed her a Baba card to give to them on arrival.

She was curious to know who it was on the card and I told her it was the same as on Tuck's locket which he always wears - that Baba was our connection! She had always wondered who it was on the locket. I told her they loved Baba. Incidentally, it occurred to me that unknown to most, Baba's picture appeared on every poster and advertising notice and all the papers for some weeks prior to their arrival. As it must do wherever they travel and perform in the world.

Anyway, when I saw Lorraine Thompson later and asked her whether they had been given the card, she said yes, and they were very happy with it.

I had prebooked tickets for our Baba group and family and had also been informed that they would be doing an audio test before and in the afternoon of their outdoor evening performance on the location. Not knowing whether one would get an opportunity to meet them at the concert - I thought there might be a chance to do so at the audio test - so I went along and sat close by amidst the few people there - purposely wearing the same Baba locket as Tuck has. The concert venue was in the old university quadrangle with a stage erected at one end.

At an opportune 'transition time' after their testing time was completed I approached the stage and spoke to them.

Tuck asked "Are you Anthony?" - we really appreciated your letter." I told Patti that two of our group here (Gavin and Marie Stevenson) remember Mani giving Patti a Baba ring in Mandali Hall when they were there - did she still have it? "Oh yes, of course", she said very amicably. They said they had been in India Nov 1980 to Jan 1981 and left just before Amatithi.

Our meeting was very short as they had to go to press interviews almost immediately, but before I left they asked us to come & see them after the concert, as they greatly enjoyed meeting people after their concerts.

So eight of us went to the evening performance and the weather was warm but overcast - by arriving early we were able to get good and close seats on peripheral stands.

The 8pm start saw a 'warm up' local group for an hour and when 9 o'clock came & Tuck & Patti appeared to a great and popular acclamation - people were all over the grassed areas. Their scheduled performance was for one hour! Instead we were treated to two & a quarter hours as it grew darker.

David, I can tell you it was so special and one felt Baba's presence STRONGLY - the whole atmosphere was charged in a relaxed air of great privilege!

The Baba group responded with many 'Jai Baba's' and at one point Tuck also 'Jai Baba'd' in a response to one strong call!

The evening grew darker as song after song - perhaps their whole recorded repertoire - enveloped us and 900 people who filled the quadrangle to capacity (it is not very large). Everyone was just so enthusiastic to this great LOVE BURST from these two hearts, who have superlative ability & artistry!

Afterwards we all went round and waited till they emerged from the 'dressing room'.

We enjoyed about 1/2 hour with them during which we discussed their only visit to India in 80/81 & that you had been at school together, & reminisced how you had introduced him to Baba. They said how they would love to come to Meherabad/Meherzad again, but find it so difficult to fit into the tight demands on them from all over the world. There was a faint possibility of them being able to make a visit in Jan 1991.

Tuck said his conviction about Baba was through reading 'THE DISCOURSES'. We talked of their Myrtle Beach visit where they met Elizabeth Patterson and of Avatar's Abode - the locality of which they were unaware.

I asked Tuck if he knew Margaret Crask had died - he didn't.

Gavin Stevenson said he thought he had seen them at 'Oceanic' in London - they confirmed being there. Ivone gave them a poem of his for Bobby McFerrin, but they said they hadn't seen him for a year as both he and they were so busy.

Claire (formally Chara Welsh) gave them some art work of hers on Baba, together with an Australian tape of Robert Welsh.

They reiterated that they would definitely come back here again - that once they had been to a place they would always intend to return.

Marianne (my wife) was absolutely entranced as were we all, with their absolute naturalness and love and the way they experienced it with such brilliant exuberance and joy - very infectious - I feel, and told them so, that they are instrumental in Baba's work - they said that they feel this to be so!

It was a true LOVE FEAST in Baba's own love - to us they appeared 'agents' for his work for the NEW HUMANITY - dispensed to all, but recognised and felt specifically by those who love the KING OF LOVE!

Please thank Mani for her lovely song for Baba's birthday, which Andrew brought with him for us and tell her that I was able to send a copy of this with her letter to Tuck and Patti in Wellington. Tuck told us here in Christchurch that they had not yet had time to play and sing it yet, but looked forward to doing so! Claire did sing it for us on Baba's birthday.


ACCORDINGLY, THE CELEBRATIONS OF BELOVED AVATAR MEHER BABA'S 100TH BIRTHDAY SHOULD BE AT THE RESPECTIVE CITIES, TOWNS AND VILLAGES WHEREVER HIS LOVERS RESIDE. THERE WILL BE NO SPECIAL BIRTHDAY CELEBRATIONS AT MEHERABAD/MEHERAZAD FOR THIS OCCASION.

MEHERAZAD WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL PILGRIMS FROM 15TH FEBRUARY 1994 TILL 1ST JULY, 1994. IN ADDITION, PLEASE FURTHER NOTE THAT THERE WILL BE NO LODGING ACCOMMODATIONS FOR EASTERN AND WESTERN PILGRIMS AT MEHERABAD, AS THIS FACILITY WILL BE SUSPENDED ON AND FROM 15TH FEBRUARY 1994 UNTIL THE NEW PILGRIM SEASON BEGINS FROM 15TH JUNE 1994.
